Literacy

Reading: 5 Star Book Recommendations Students have been crafting the art of book recommendations to entice others to read their favorite books!

Writing: Poetry Workshop

Twice a month, students peruse a number of poetry books to find a poem that speaks to them on a personal level. They record the poem, its author and then illustrate the page in their Poetry Journal. When all are completed, students partake in a museum style poetry walk!

Word Work: High Frequency Word Importance!

In class, we have talked about common, reoccurring words that show up in our writing, called high frequency words. Knowing these words can help students to become better readers and writers!



- Mathematicians have been consulting for "Brad's Baseball Company," designing three-dimensional boxes (a.k.a. rectangular prisms), to assist Brad in his package decision-making.
- Each month, students receive a Number Corner practice packet, used for follow-up practice when introducing concepts. Pages may be incomplete do not be concerned! These are on hand if/when they fit into the daily lesson, but are not required work.

What you can do: *Reading is Thinking* It would be helpful if students continued their reading practices at home. If your child gets stuck or confused during a portion of their reading, they can use these strategies:

- Readers reread the sentence, paragraph or page -
- Readers ask themselves, 'Who, What & Where'
- Readers read further to gain more understanding Readers stop & think about they already know
