Reading: Students have been keeping a close eye on their thinking process during reading. Sticky notes double as valuable 'think marks' which are later recorded in their brand new readers journals!

<u>Writing</u>: Personal narratives have taken 5th grade by storm as students write in a fast and furious manner. They have not generated strategies for narrative ideas, but also have started learning about techniques to raise their level of writing. Stay tuned for some great stories.




